SDS data requirements under REACH and CLP along the supply chain

Due to the increase in worldwide Safety Data Sheet (SDS) requirements linked to the obligation to ensure up- and downstream communication and company internal hazardous material management, it is expected that there will be escalating cost and effort along the complete supply chain. Different European institutions have therefore already developed or are in progress to develop IT solutions with an integrated XML interface.

The main objective of this workshop is to show which data are required from which member of the supply-chain for in-house data management in order to fulfill all REACH and other national legal requirements. Implemented XML standards and examples will be presented by different industry groups and IT providers. Target groups include manufacturers and importers of substances and mixtures, down-stream users (formulators, distributors) and end-users (e.g. manufacturers of articles).
