Due to the increase in worldwide Safety Data Sheet (SDS) requirements linked to the obligation to ensure upand downstream communication and company internal hazardous material management, it is expected that

The main objective of this workshop is to show which data are required from which member of the supply-chain
for in-house data management in order to fulfill all REACH and other national legal requirements. Implemented
XML standards and examples will be presented by different industry groups and IT providers. Target groups
