Due to the increase in worldwide Safety Data Sheet (SDS) requirements linked to the obligation to provide up- and downstream communication and company internal hazardous material management, it is envisaged that there will be an escalating cost and effort along the complete supply chain. To maintain competitiveness, reduce effort and to keep costs down, it is essential to switch from the current paper based management to an easy-to-handle paperless SDS communication between manufacturers, importers, only representatives and downstream users. Different European institutions have developed IT solutions which are already in use e.g. in parts of the automotive industry and end-users in other industry sectors. The main objective of this workshop is to present currently available open XML standards and examples on how they have been implemented by different industry groups. Target groups include downstream users, manufacturers of articles and manufacturers and importers of substances and mixtures.
