Structured exchange of Safety Data Sheet data is the basis of paperless future communication along the supply chain. Open standards for XML schemas and phrase content are now ready, and the resulting non-proprietary data exchange is essential for user acceptance. Implementation activities have started across Europe and deliver customer feedback.

This conference shares information on these early projects, and aims to enable experts among software companies and users of hazardous products to assess the applicability and implementation steps for their IT environment: How mature are standards now? How are phrases and XML applied together? When is the best time to implement?

- In this context the process of mapping as a starting point in every implementation project will be focused as well as the discussion of implementing an appropriate future organisation structure for maintaining and further developing the open standard SDScomXML. The conclusion will be fed back into the standardisation working groups in order to strengthen the open industry standards. Decision takers among the supply chain stakeholders, IT providers and other interested parties are kindly invited to participate.
